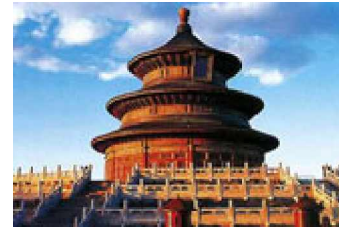


## A Touch of China

## Day-by-Day Itinerary

### Day 1:

Enter the largest imperial city, the Forbidden City through Tiananmen Square, site of many historic events. Continue on to the Temple of Heaven, an outstanding example of Chinese religious architecture where the emperors prayed for good harvests.

### Day 4:

Visit to Summer Palace, a spectacular complex of palaces and pagodas. The tour continues with an afternoon visit to the Lama Temple.

**Meals:** Breakfast & Lunch

### Day 5:

Fly on to Shanghai, the "Paris of the East". Check in at hotel. The journey through Shanghai begins with a stroll along the historic International Concession "The Bund" on the banks of the Huangpu River. Browse through the shops along Nanjing Road, China's "Fifth Avenue" and visit to the Yu Garden, which is located in Old Shanghai.

**Meals:** Breakfast & Lunch

### Day 6:

Visit to the Shanghai Art Museum with more than 120,000 of China's most valuable artistic treasures. In the afternoon visit to the exquisite Jade Buddha Temple.

### Day 7:

Transfer to the new International airport to board the flight back.
